◆ 4. FIRST AID MEASURE

(1) FIRST AID MEASURES FOR ACCIDENTAL:

- Eye Exposure: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water for at least 15 minutes. Seek medical attention if irritation develops or persists or if visual changes occur.
